

Change of school type

A change of school type is possible if following criteria are met:

1. A change of school type is usually only possible at the end of the school year.
2. The class conference decides in exceptional cases for a change in the middle of the school year.
3. A change of school type is possible after grade 7 until the beginning of grade 10.
4. For the assignment/classification of grade 6 and 7 the existing regulation applies (see 8.4.1 of quality handbook).
5. A change of school type has to be applied for until June 1st of the current school year.
6. A change from A-levels (Gymnasium) to O-levels (Realschule) or from O-levels (Realschule) to secondary modern school (Hauptschule) is also possible if the transfer into the next higher class will not be reached because the grade “deficient” (“mangelhaft) or “insufficient” (“ungenügend”) has been attained in the subject French. In all other cases of no transfer, the class conference will decide.
7. A change from secondary modern school (Hauptschule) to O-levels (Realschule) is possible under following requirements:
After grade 9: Qualified secondary modern school degree (Hauptschulabschluss) (see 8.4.3 of quality handbook);
otherwise: a grade point average of minimum 2,33 in the subjects German, Math and English as well as a grade point average of minimum 2,50 in all other subjects relevant for transfer. The subject French can be attended; the subject matter has to be caught up on one’s own responsibility and is relevant for transfer as of the first year of transfer.
8. A change from O-levels (Realschule) to A-levels (Gymnasium) is possible under following requirements:
A grade point average of minimum 2,33 in the subjects German, Math and English as well as a grade point average of minimum 2,50 in all other subjects relevant for transfer. The subject

matter in French has to be caught up on one's own responsibility if the subject has not been attended so far.
